ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SERVICE  
STORM COST RECOVERY RIDER

DESCRIPTION:

The Storm Cost Recovery Rider is intended to compensate AES Ohio for certain costs related to restoring service and repairing distribution facilities as a result of severe storms that the Company experienced.

APPLICABLE:

This rider will be assessed per tariff class at the rates stated below on a bills rendered basis beginning December 1, 2023.

CHARGES:

Residential	\$ 1.82 / month
Residential Heating	\$ 1.82 / month
Secondary	\$ 6.34 / month
Primary	\$ 6.34 / month
Primary Substation	\$ 6.34 / month
High Voltage	\$ 6.34 / month
Private Outdoor Lighting	\$ 0.40 / month
Street Lighting	\$ 6.34 / month

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The Storm Cost Recovery Rider shall be adjusted semi-annually to recover amounts authorized by the Commission. This Rider is subject to reconciliation or adjustment, including but not limited to, increases or refunds, based on the results of audits as approved and ordered by the Commission.
